Subject: Directives RoHS 2011/65/UE of 08/06/2011.

Dear customer,

To answer your request, we inform you that copper products we manufacture contain only little traces of **cadmium** and **lead**, among the substances listed by the Directive. There is no mercury, no hexavalent chromium, no PBB and no PBDE. Consequently our products are in conformance with the RoHS directive.

The lead quantity is very low. The maximal quantity allowed is 50 ppm (EN 1976 standard), equivalent to 50 g for 1000 kg of copper.

The Cadmium quantity is lower. It is between 0.1 ppm, (0.1 g for 1000 kg of copper) and 0.5 ppm, (also regarding the EN 1976 Standard).

These substances are a part of all impurities inherent at this type of raw material, you'll find those presented in an example of chemical analysis of Cu-ETP copper, analysis attached to this letter.

Moreover, we respect all the regulations applicable in our activity and attach a great importance to the raw materials we supply.

Moreover, our copper products are completely recyclable.
